"The Tempest takes place on a magical island, 'full of noises,' ruled by the wizard Prospero.

Pip Greasley listens to places in order to compose, and creates music from the sounds that surround bim.

Hilary Westlake spins ideas into dramatic strands, weaves them into mighty dramas, defines her 'island' of theatrical action, and tranforms it into a place of power and enchantment.

Colin Pearce creates symbols that conjure up the spirit of a place. In the Tempest the 'drowned man' is the King of Naples. In Out of the Bull, Colin Pearce has created a diver who leaves the world of men behind, becomes immersed in an underwater world, and lives again, utterly changed by the 'rich' 'strange' alchemy of the sea."

HILARY WESTLAKE is an expert storyteller, a world class director, and an original 'painter' of vast theatrical 'pictures' involving huge numbers of people.

He is the Artistic Director of "Solid State Opera" and has composed many scores for film, television, theatre and dance, as well as creating large scale multimedia works, including his award winning "5 K Pursuit Opera" for Channel 4. '5 K' starred two teams of champion cyclists and was staged in a computerised interactive environment, built in a velodrome.


Out of the Blue - like its plant - is a 'hybrid'!
